SUBJECT: MLC CERTIFICATE. DATE: JULY 19<sup>TH</sup>, 2018.

## **Dear Exclusive Surveyors**

The purpose of this letter is to inform to all exclusive surveyors the terms established by the MLC to carry out the renewal inspections and make the necessary coordination with the operators, taking into account that the ROs authorized to issue the maritime labour certificate have the obligation to request the administration, with time, any type of authorization that they require so that the vessel is not detained when the inspection is not carried out in the period established by the MLC'.

- IF THE RENEWAL INSPECTION HAS BEEN COMPLETED WITHIN **THREE MONTHS BEFORE** THE EXPIRY OF THE EXISTING MARITIME LABOUR CERTIFICATE, THE NEW MARITIME LABOUR CERTIFICATE SHALL BE VALID FROM THE DATE OF COMPLETION OF THE RENEWAL INSPECTION FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING FIVE YEARS FROM THE DATE OF EXPIRY OF THE EXISTING CERTIFICATE ACCORDING TO THE STANDARD A 5.1.3.3 OF THE MLC.
- IF THE RENEWAL INSPECTION IS COMPLETED MORE THAN THREE MONTHS BEFORE THE EXPIRY
  DATE OF THE EXISTING MARITIME LABOUR CERTIFICATE, THE NEW MARITIME LABOUR CERTIFICATE
  SHALL BE VALID FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING FIVE YEARS STARTING FROM THE DATE OF
  COMPLETION OF THE RENEWAL INSPECTION ACCORDING TO THE STANDARD A5.1.3.4 OF THE MLC.
